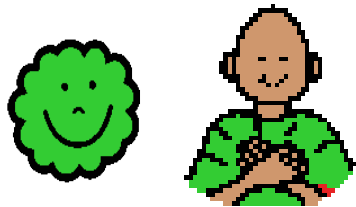




Staying safe on field trips
