











## Social Skill Board












































































The skills card was posted in a frame that sat on the table. With the skills card is a reinforcement sheet that when a student used the skill we were focusing on during the group time we would mark off a circle. It easily slides in a protection sheet and can be hung on a string to go around the leaders neck so all students can see if we are meeting the goal. If the group reached there goal there was a surprise at the end.

Also the trifold was made so it could sit in the middle of the table as a visual support to use with students. It goes front to back, laminate it and can go either way.
