The **Kansas Education Employment Board (KEEB)** is a free recruitment service aimed at attracting highly qualified candidates to Kansas education jobs. **KEEB** provides an innovative, user-friendly universal recruitment and employment website (www.kansasteachingjobs.com) that Kansas schools and universities can use to advertise job openings. **KEEB** allows applicants to apply for positions electronically and provides information on licensure, state sponsored tuition and scholarship programs, and resume assistance. **KEEB** is funded by the Kansas State Department of Education and administered by the Southeast Kansas Education Service Center (Greenbush).

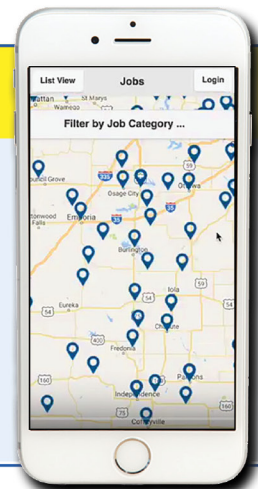

NEW JOB MAPPING FEATURE FOR APPLICANTS AND EMPLOYERS

KEEB has introduced a new app that allows applicants to view jobs matching their certification in map form from their mobile devices and desktop computers. Employers can search for applicants who have selected their profiles to be viewable and have logged into their account within the last 90 days. The results are available in map form showing job seekers by certification.
