

Safety in the Hallway

Location: Hallway	Behaviors Addressed: Safety
Expectation 1: Follow the traffic flow pattern	
Teach Examples and Non-Examples of Meeting Behavioral Expectations:	
Demonstrate EXAMPLES (What to Do)	Demonstrate NON-EXAMPLES (What NOT To Do)
1. Walk on the right side of the hall using tiles 4-9.	Walk in the locker zone, tiles 1-3. Walk on the left side of the hallway. Spread out across the whole hallway with a chain of students.
2. Follow stairway rules. Enter stairwell using door with green “GO” sign. Go up the up staircase and down the down staircase.	Enter stairwell using the red “STOP” sign. Go up the down staircase or go down the up staircase.
3. Use continuous walking movement on the green tiles.	Stop in the green tile zone.
Model: Teacher models the behaviors with the help of students, then <u>all</u> students practice and model behaviors to indicate understanding.	
Feedback: Recognize students using specific positive feedback paired with a ticket for demonstrating hallway safety.	

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
