

Through the **Kansas State Department of Education (KSDE)**, the **Kansas Education Employment Board (KEEB)**, administered by the Southeast Kansas Education Service Center (Greenbush), is a free recruitment service aimed at attracting highly qualified candidates to Kansas education jobs.



KEEB provides an innovative, user-friendly, universal recruitment and employment website (www.kansasteachingjobs.com) that Kansas schools and universities can use to advertise job openings. KEEB allows applicants to apply for positions electronically and provides information on licensure, state sponsored tuition and scholarship programs, and resume assistance.

KEEB PROVIDES FREE RECRUITMENT SERVICES

During the 2017-18 school year, the KEEB website amassed 1,102,851 pageviews, averaging 91,904 pageviews per month. As of Fall 2018, there were 14,179 active registrations on KEEB. In addition to Kansans, who are the site's primary audience, individuals from 48 other states and 30 other nations have registered on the website.

KEEB is utilized by school districts and colleges throughout Kansas:

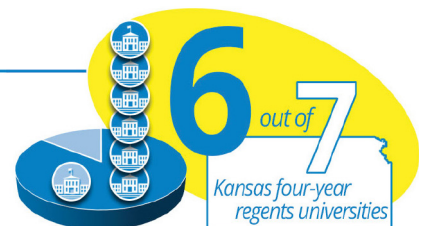
- Every school district in Kansas has used the www.kansasteachingjobs.com website to recruit educators.

Since 2011, 41,777 applications have been submitted through KEEB. This free recruitment service enables applicants to identify positions by job category, certification, search terms, and/or location. Applicants can upload their resumes and other pertinent documents to their portfolios, streamlining the application process. KEEB has introduced an app that allows applicants to view jobs matching their certification in map form from their mobile device(s) and desktop computers.

JOB MAPPING FEATURE FOR EMPLOYERS

Searching for an educator with specific qualifications who lives in your area of the state? Employers can search for applicants who have selected their profiles to be viewable and have logged into their account within the last 90 days. The results are available in map form showing job seekers by certification.
