

Assessment Tools for the Communication Domain

Assessment	Age	Description
*Children's Communication Checklist, 2nd Edition (CCC-2)	4-17 years old	The CCC-2 is a 70-item checklist used to measure pragmatics (i.e., social-communication) that is completed by an adult who knows the child well (e.g., family, therapist, teacher). The CCC provides a total scaled score and ten normed subscales
**Pragmatic Language Checklist	4+	Assessment based on an observation checklist. Looks at general conversation and nonverbal conversational skills.
*Conversation Effectiveness Profile-Revised (CEP-R)	K-Adult	A checklist that measure appropriate behavior within conversations.
**Dyssemia Rating Scale	K-12	A nonverbal social communication rating scale. Cut-off scores indicate severity.
**The Communication Matrix	Begins at earliest stages of communication	Looks at how a person is communicating by beginning at the basic foundations to expressive language.
*Clinical Evaluation of Language Fundamentals-5 (CELF- 5)	5-21 years old	Standardized comprehensive assessment of expressive and receptive language skills.
**Chapel Hill Teacher's Rating Scale Pragmatic Language Skills	K-3	Rating scale of 14 items in Likert form including Nonverbal communication skills and General

		Conversations Skills.
**Chapel Hill Teacher's Rating Scale Pragmatic Language Skills	4th-12	Rating scale of 14 items in Likert form including Nonverbal communication skills and General Conversations Skills.
*Social Language Development Test	6-17.11 years old	Standardized assessment of social language development in children.
