


-KANSAS EDUCATION EMPLOYMENT BOARD



Through the Kansas State Department of Education (KSDE), the Kansas Education Employment Board (KEEB), administered by the Southeast Kansas Education Service Center (Greenbush), is a free recruitment service aimed at attracting highly qualified candidates to Kansas education jobs. KEEB provides an innovative, user-friendly, universal recruitment and employment website (www.kansasteachingjobs.com) that Kansas schools and universities can use to advertise job openings. KEEB allows applicants to apply for positions electronically and provides information on licensure, state sponsored tuition and scholarship programs, and resumé assistance. Additionally, KEEB produces the annual Kansas Special Education Attrition Report to determine the number of individuals leaving special education position in Kansas each year.

KEEB PROVIDES FREE RECRUITMENT SERVICES



During the 2019—20 school year, the KEEB website amassed 666,196 pageviews, averaging 55,516 pageviews per month. In addition to the Kansans who are the site's primary audience,

individuals from 49 other states and 27 other nations have accounts on the website.

KEEB is utilized by school districts throughout Kansas, and every school district in Kansas has



used the <u>www.kansasteachingjobs.com</u> website to recruit educators. Top job categories with vacancies during the 2019–20 school year included elementary, secondary, special education, coaching, and administration positions.

As of August 2020, more than 5,800 applicants had logged

into the KEEB website within the last 24 months. A total of 5,442 jobs were posted through the website between July 1, 2019 and August 1, 2020. This free recruitment service enables applicants to identify positions by job category, certification, search terms, and/or location. Applicants can upload their resumés and other pertinent documents to their portfolios, streamlining the application process.



KEEB HELPS DISTRICTS FIND QUALIFIED JOB SEEKERS

KEEB provides an app, in map form, allowing applicants to access job postings matching their certifications. By hovering over or clicking on an icon, potential applicants can navigate to specific job openings in their preferred region of the state. Employers can search for applicants who have selected their profiles to be viewable and have logged into their account within the last 90 days. The results are available in map form, showing job seekers by certification.

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, KEEB expanded their search and posting tools to meet the needs of districts. These included adding categories for virtual or remote positions and designing flexible searches for positions that might be shared across multiple districts. The social media presence was also increased with a focus on expanding the pool of substitute teachers.
