Visual Instruction (VI): Visual information which tells the student how to complete the task. (Pictured or written instructions, cut outs/slots, modeling)

Visual Clarity (VC): Visually highlight or clarify relevant details. (Check boxes, highlighting, Shows how many, labeling, photos, self-correcting, etc.)

Visual Organization (VO): Organize materials and space, limit distractions. (Limit information, separate materials, stabilize materials, self-contained tasks, etc.)
