# How Adults Change the Probability of Behavior



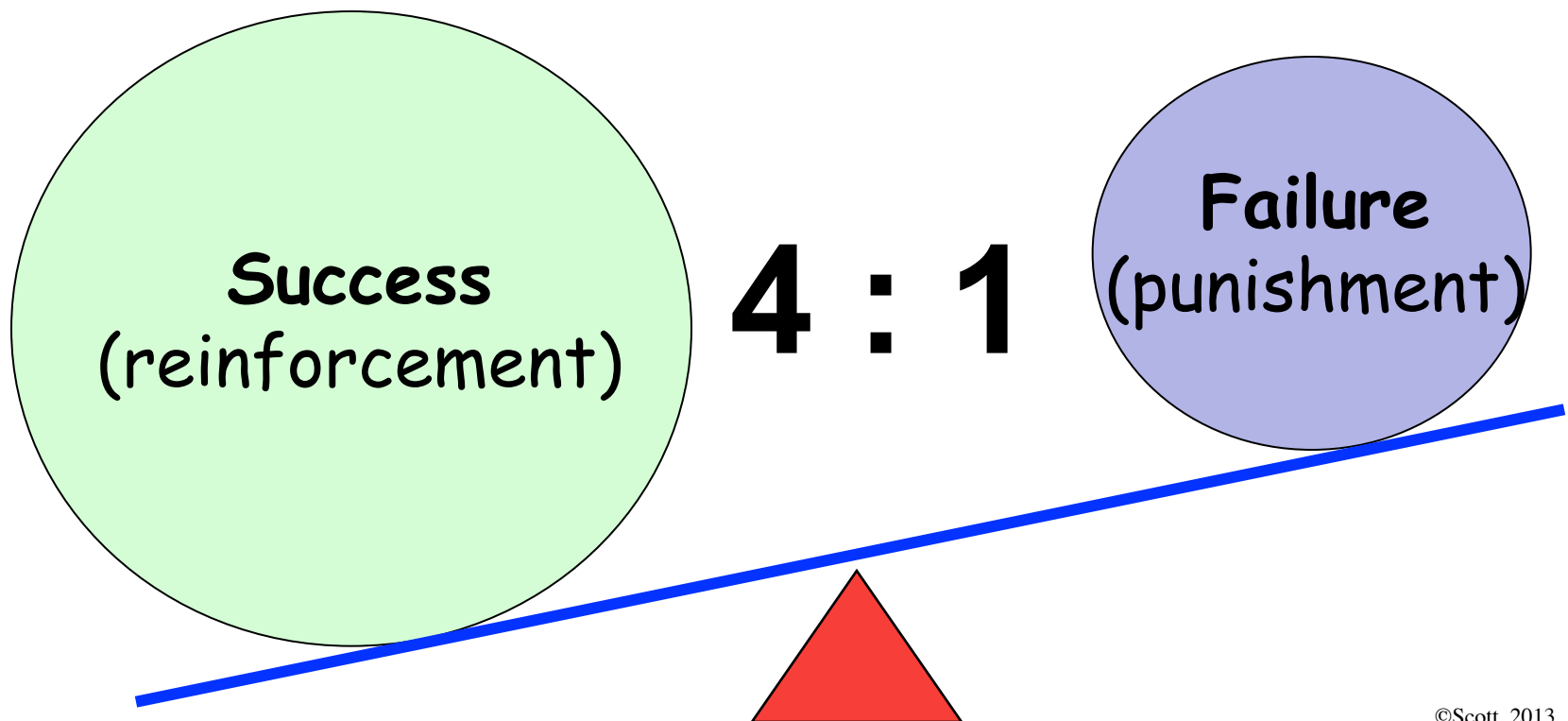
# Responsible Teaching is Fixing the Environment in Favor of Success

Discipline is the actions parents and teachers take to increase student success (Charles, 1980).



# Fixing the Environment Works When . . .

We create more positive than negative  
outcomes (i.e. success > failure)



## ***Assessing predictable relationships between the environment and behavior***

# **FBA**

- Involves gathering information from all those who know student
- Predict when/where behavior problems will occur
- Determine why problems occur
- The purpose is to get the information necessary to create a successful plan
