For the sake of co-teachers' anonymity, a reporting window must contain at least five observations in order for a summary report to be displayed. Only reporting windows for which a report is available will be displayed to you. If no reporting windows are available, that means that no reporting window contains the minimum of five observations for your district. You are still always able to view completed individual observations through the system.

4. Once you have clicked on the report you wish to view, give the system a minute to generate your report. Depending on the number of observations and your internet connection speed, the report generation process may take a moment.
